The Steve Engle Scholarships will be awarded to a deserving high school graduating senior or college student that resides in the Northern Pima County area.

The applications are judged on student need, future goals & objectives, service to school and community, a Letters of Recommendation, from non-family members, an Essay, and an interview with the Scholarship Program Committee. Each of these criteria will be evaluated for a total score.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

1. The applicant must be a high school graduate or attending college student.
2. Applications must be received or delivered to the office of the Northern Pima County Chamber of Commerce no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 14, 2008.
3. Students whose parents are members, Directors and Officers of the Northern Pima County Chamber of Commerce are eligible.
4. Scholarship interviews will be scheduled during the week of April 7, 2008. The scholarship will be awarded during the Chamber's Monthly Membership Breakfast on April 24, 2008 and the winner will be invited to speak.
5. All applications must be typed and filled out completely.
6. **Failure to include all required data in the format requested will result in disqualification.**

1. List membership in all clubs, sports programs and organizations.
2. List any awards, honors or recognitions (Academic, Civic, Talent) received.
3. Specify any service to the community, church or school.
4. Indicate details of part time employment (Include data & brief description of position(s) held.)
5. List the colleges and/or technical schools to which applicant has been made and/or admitted or is currently attending. Also, describe your proposed field of study.
6. ESSAY: Why did you choose this field and what are your goals and objectives for the future?
7. If you could meet anyone in the world (living or deceased), who would it be? Tell us why.
8. 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> semester high school transcript or a current college transcript.
9. Statement of financial situation. Please include the following:
  - a. Family unit and current living situation
  - b. Why is scholarship support needed? What other scholarships or sources of support do you have for you future education?
  - c. What have you done to provide for your financial support?
  - d. What else do you plan to do to provide for your future educational funding?

**DON'T FORGET:**

Attach your letters of recommendation ( no more than 3) and any other documents you feel will illustrate your goals and character.

**SCORING SYSTEM-**

Initial screening criteria include: 50% Student Need, 40% Goals, and 10% Community Service.

Finalist selection criteria include: 50% interview, 50% student need.

## E.S. "Steve" Engle

Mayor Engle was one of Oro Valley's founding fathers and served as Mayor of the Town of Oro Valley from 1978 to 1990. He was loved and respected by his staff, peers and fellow citizens. As a founding father in 1970, Steve Engle began working towards the incorporation of Oro Valley, which occurred in April 1974. He continued to contribute his time to the Town until his retirement as mayor in May 1990.

In addition to the Mayor's many duties, he loved young people and often greeted students from Oro Valley schools at the Town Hall to conduct "mock Council meetings" and talk about the role of local government. Up until his death in 1990, Mayor Engle presented deserving students with scholarship funds to help pay 1 year's college tuition. After his death, the first Oro Valley Chamber of Commerce started a scholarship program for deserving Oro Valley students in honor of Mayor Steve Engle.
